| WHAT IS THE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM? | The Transitional Housing Program Plus (THP Plus) is a supportive housing program serving former foster and probation youth. Youth participating in the program obtain independent housing in the community and meet regularly with THP Plus Coordinators to work on independent living goals. By offering services in a real life environment, the program promotes the self-confidence and financial stability necessary for youth to make a successful transition to living independently in the community. |
| WHAT SERVICES DOES THE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM PROVIDE? | Resources and supportive services include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Financial assistance with rent, utilities, food, and educational expenses• Emotional support• Life skills coaching• Assistance with accessing other community resources |
| AM I ELIGIBLE? | Eligible youth between the ages of 18-24 who have emancipated from foster care or who were in an out of home probation placement are eligible for THP Plus services. |
